Our scholarship program is aiming at international students and graduates who have acquired a university degree and who intend to complete postgraduate or master studies, doctoral studies or a research stay of at least four semesters at a university in Germany.

- have a university degree and above-average academic performance,
- have good knowledge of the German language,
- are actively engaged in voluntary work,
- plan to study a minimum of four semesters at any university in Germany,
- support democracy, rule of law and human rights.
