- Field Research of up to 6 months
- Internships, summer schools/programs and practical education of up to 6 months

Requirements

- No age limit
- Thematically relevant field of studies in which KAS operates (Law, Political Science, Macroeconomics and International Relations, Media, Public Administration etc.)
- High commitment, excellent academic record and high social and/or political engagement
- Scholarship will only be provided if the applicant fulfils all requirements of the institution of interest
- *In case of acceptance*: regular submission of a comprehensive report to KAS on a three-month basis is required

Application Process

Applications need to be received by KAS well in advance (3 months prior to program start). The following documents are to be submitted by the applicant (before submission, please contact our office to acquire more information on the application process):

- CV
- Application questionnaire (available at KAS)
- Cover Letter
- Degree and other relevant certificates
- Health certificate (for education outside of Cambodia only)
- At least 2 letters of recommendation
- Confirmation letter of the applied for institution
- Interview with KAS' country representative
- Writing test (*if applicable*)
- Other additional documents may be requested
