

Internship in New York – global KAS-Rule of Law Programme

As part of the cooperation between the Konrad-Adenauer Foundation and the UN Special Rapporteur on the independence of judges and lawyers, Dr. Diego Garcia Sayán, we offer an internship in New York from August 1, 2018 for a minimum of 3 months.

Since 1990 the Konrad-Adenauer foundation has been supplementing its global projects with the transnational, worldwide Rule of Law Programme. Its bases are Bogotá for Latin America, Singapore for Asia, Nairobi for Sub-Saharan Africa, Bucharest for South-East Europe and Beirut for Middle East/North Africa. The global programme is coordinated from Berlin. The work of the foundation in New York focuses on the United Nations, building up synergies between the foundation's partners all over the world and the UN.

You will be involved in the everyday work of an international organization with an interesting and diversified work environment in New York. Thus, this will be a valuable enrichment for your studies through practical experiences and a useful network in the world of politics and social sciences.

Requirements:

- studies in law or at least law as secondary studies
- very good command of English
- Spanish is desirable
- commitment, flexibility and team spirit
- enthusiasm for working in a political environment
- knowledge of the usual office applications and open-minded approach in using social media tools

Tasks:

- supporting the work of the UN Special Rapporteur
- supporting the work of the Konrad-Adenauer-foundation's office in New York
- assistance in the organization of a conference on "Judicial Independence" in Strasbourg

The internship period is at least three months. The position is not paid. However, for German citizens there is the possibility to apply for a DAAD scholarship:
