## “Promoting efficient interaction between the National Assembly and civil society in Vietnam” (EuropeAid/128807/L/ACT/VN)

The project is implemented by Konrad-Adenauer-Stiftung in cooperation with the Institute for State and Law (ISL), the Vietnamese Lawyers Association (VLA), and the Department of Foreign Affairs of the National Assembly Office.

The project aims at assessing and implementing ways to improve the work of the National Assembly of Vietnam (NA). One of its components focuses on the dialogue between the members of the NA and the people of their constituencies, while the other will deal with the qualification and information needs of the members of the NA. It will target the organizational infrastructure already in existence and try to support it by formalizing knowledge distribution and contacts to agents of relevant sciences.

The project's main office is located in the country office of the Konrad-Adenauer-Stiftung e.V. in Hanoi, Vietnam. It has officially started on November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 and has a running time of 24 months. During that time several studies, workshops, trainings and conferences will be realized. Successful applicants will take part in the organization and implementation of project activities, assist the project's visibility actions and will be involved in drafting internal documents.

Applicants should be master students of Regional Studies Southeast Asia, Political Sciences, Law or Sociology interested in working within a culturally different environment. Basic knowledge of the political situation in Vietnam and first intercultural experiences are required. Official project language is English, while knowledge of the German language would be an asset.
