










Public Trust in Government












Incumbents-September of Election Year



Misery Index During an Election Year



"How likely do you think it is that today's youth will have a better life than their parents -- very likely, somewhat likely, somewhat unlikely, or very unlikely?"




President's Approval Rating Less than 50%




Approval Rating Among Incumbents in October of an Election Year



12% Congressional Approval Rating at Record Low











America Remains a Center Right Country

t polling data shows conservatives were a greater percentage of the electorate than any time since at least 1976.




Can the President Turn Out His Base?











But What About Herman Cain?


70% of those who saw the debates say the more they learn about Herman Cain, the more they like him. Among tea party supporters, Cain's support has surged from 5% to 30% in a month.








Obama Loses a Net of 6 Electoral Votes

Historically, very consequential period for the U.S.


Facing unprecedented fourth change election in a row; politics remains tumultuous.
