The Konrad Adenauer Stiftung's Rule of Law Program team comprising of Dr. Arne Wulff, Mr. Peter Wendoh and Ms Marie-Laura Schmitt held bilateral meetings with the Judge Presidents of the African Court on Human and Peoples' Rights and the East African Court of Justice in Arusha, Tanzania.



At the African Court, the team held talks with the Judge President Justice Sylvain Oré where a number of collaborative initiatives between the Court and KAS were discussed. In attendance were Justice Ben Kioko, Vice President of the Court and Dr. Robert Eno, Registrar of the Court. Both sides exchanged useful literature that they have produced in the recent past. Thereafter the KAS team attended a public hearing in the

matter of Ingabire Victoire Umuhoza v. The Republic of Rwanda.

Another bilateral meeting was held with Justice Dr. Emmanuel Ugirashebuja, Judge President of the East African Court of Justice at the Mt. Meru Hotel in Arusha where various initiatives towards the strengthening of the already existing collaboration between the two institutions were discussed.
