### Internship at CORRECTIV from September - November 2018 in Berlin

Have you ever thought about working as a journalist in Europe? Here comes the opportunity for you to work with the investigative newsroom CORRECTIV in Berlin.

The **Adenauer Fellowship for Media & Communications** will support one Asian investigative journalist to do an internship at CORRECTIV for three months. In the course of the internship you will publish a number of different stories together with reporters of CORRECTIV. The stories will be published in English and German language, and you are free to publish the stories additionally in your native language.

## The future fellow should fulfil the following criteria:

- Asian citizen
- 35 years of age or below
- at least two years of experiences as a journalist
- first experiences in investigative journalism
- fluent in written and spoken English

#### The fellowship includes:

- Flight to and from Berlin
- EUR 2.000 per month for living costs and other costs (overseas health insurance/visa for Germany)

#### **Information about application:**

The internship will start on 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2018.

- 1. CV
- 2. Cover letter explaining your experience in investigative journalism and main field of expertise
- 3. Two work samples
