





The House of Plenty A SOCIAL INNOVATION MODEL



The Three "Building Blocks" of the Swedish Model




Vulnerability in the Context of Sexual Exploitation




Sexual Exploitation beyond the context of Human Trafficking






Defining Sexual Exploitation




Shifting the burden of Prostitution

The studies have shown that the Sex Purchase Act has succeeded in shifting the liability by criminalising the purchase of sexual services. However, shifting the burden of prostitution will require the effective implementation of the social component and that requires long-term, sustainable funding.
