Zelda la Grange started her career in 1992 and in 1994 applied for a job in the Office of the first democratic Presidency. In 1999, President Mandela hand-picked her from his personal staff to remain in his services beyond retirement. Zelda served President Mandela in various capacities over 19 years including Executive Personal Assistant and Spokesperson until his death on 5 December 2013. On June 19th 2014 she published her memoirs entitled "Good Morning, Mr Mandela". 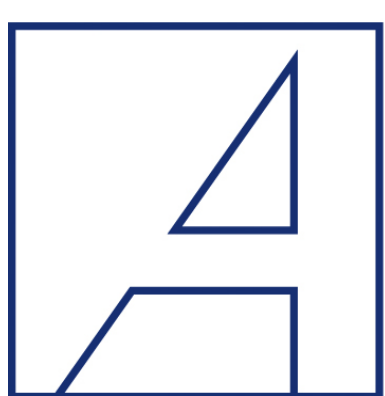
