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## CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

### What is the registration fee?

The idea of the tournament is to give you a tool to combine the Life Orientation topic Environmental Awareness with Physical Education and to teach valuable skills and knowledge to the youth. The manual that will be handed out to you will equip you to be able to carry out the lessons in school. We do not ask a registration fee but it is your school's own responsibility to cover transport for teachers, coaches and players to the venue. On the day we will provide a well organised competition, fun games and activities, catering, and as well there will be a small lucky-draw for kids to win prizes.

### What do we need to prepare for the tournament?

Prepare your team in playing handball and work together as a team for a healthy environment at your school and community. **We ask you to do an ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS PROJECT to be carry-out before the tournament at your school/club.** The main topic for this year's project is **WATER SCARCITY**. South Africa has been experienced a huge drought. **We like you as a team to come up with solution how you can solve this problem in your school and homes. How can you save Water and implement the ideas at school!** Create a poster as a proof of action and bring it to the tournament. These and any other items will be exhibited at the tournament.

Please note: Teams who are not able to fulfil the requested task and don't bring their proof of action to the tournament, points will be deducted in the general handball competition.
