Age Groups: U12 Mix and U 14 Mix (minimum of 2 girls at every time on the field)

Teams: 10 players plus 2 coaches/teachers (minimum 3 girls per team)

Registration fee: There is no registration fee, but we ask you to cover your own transport

Team Project that needs to be fulfilled before the tournament:

We ask you to do an ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS PROJECT to be carry-out before the tournament at your school/club. The main topic for this year's project is ZERO-Waste School. Come up with ideas how to become a ZERO-Waste School and showcase them at the tournament: Please prepare for the tournament:

- Create a poster "Our Zero-Waste-School" or other items to showcase in an exhibition (Proof of Action)
- Extra-Points will be given for ECO-Bricks-Challenge: Do a Community and School-Clean-Up with your team/school, produce Eco-bricks from non-recyclable plastic and bring them to the tournament.

PLEASE NOTE: Teams who are not able to fulfil the requested task and don't bring their proof of action to the tournament, points will be deducted in the general handball competition.



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
