EVENT REPORT

The International Youth Summit "Celebrating New India" on Multilateralism and Youth, was jointly organised by the iLEAD Global Foundation, the India Office of Konrad-Adenauer-Stiftung (KAS) and the International Young Democrat Union (IYDU) on 28th October in New Delhi. The summit was held to mark the 75th anniversary of Indian independence. "Celebrating New India" aims to engage the leading political and business minds as well as prominent leaders from the civil society and academia to shape national, regional and industry agendas. Delegates from eleven countries, renowned think-tanks, academic institutions and universities participated in the summit. The IYDU Council was held as a sideline meeting to the summit.

In the first panel discussion on 'Global Challenges: The War Within and Without' moderated by Mr. Abhishek Pratab Singh, Member of the Hindi Advisory Committee under the Govt. of India, the panellists, Dr. Adrian Haack, Director of Konrad-Adenauer-Stiftung India, Lt. Gen. Arun Kr Sahni, Indian Army, and Ms. Marwa El Ansari, Member of the IYDU, discussed the challenges prevailing in the current geopolitical framework i.e. from climate change to various forms of terrorism.
