Scholarship Guidelines

What is the KAS scholarship programme?

The Konrad-Adenauer-Stiftung (KAS) promotes higher education of not only Germans but also of nationals of other countries at universities in the Federal Republic of Germany. The KAS scholarship programme offers students the opportunity to obtain a German university degree, thus deepening their domain knowledge. KAS aims to contribute to the field of education and expects its scholarship holders to assume responsibility in their respective domains after returning to their home country.

There are two types of scholarships:

- 1. **International Programmes (IP)** This scholarship programme is managed by the European and International Cooperation department (Europäische und Internationale Zusammenarbeit **EIZ**)
- 2. **Scholarship Programme for International Students** This scholarship programme is managed by the Scholarships and Cultural Activities department (Begabtenförderung und Kultur **BK**)
