Journalist Academy

(February 2015, Ramallah)

The Konrad-Adenauer-Foundation in Ramallah announces its intercultural German-Palestinian journalist academy, which will be held from **13 February to 23 February**, **2015 in Ramallah**.

The theme of the academy:

"The Palestinians – different from what you expected"

We are looking for <u>eight (8)</u> ambitious and experienced journalists - female or male - <u>from either the West Bank, East Jerusalem or Gaza</u> to join the seven participants from Germany. Together they will receive trainings and conduct research in mixed, intercultural teams to produce articles that will be published in Arabic and German. The working and instruction language will be English. The center of all activities will be Ramallah, but the teams are free to travel around to conduct their research and interviews. All expenses (hotel, travel and food) are being covered by the Konrad-Adenauer-Foundation.

Required qualifications and experience:

- Experience in working as a journalist, either as a freelancer or at a local newspaper or news agency
- Very good command of English
- A high level of commitment, meaning full availability during the 10 days of the academy

A full application should include:

- A cover letter stating your motivation/desire to take part in the academy
- Your CV
- Two-three writing samples, meaning recently published works/articles (Arabic or English)
- All documents should be combined in a single PDF or Word-document
