

Research Design/Procedure




Research Design/Procedure

- Survey founders:
 - indepth interviews by trained interviewer
 - with 70 founders from all over the world
 - October 1st 2013-2014 in their mother languages in transcription
- Survey students:
 - internet questionnaire via link (soscisurvey)
 - to all upper schools and students from the first and second semester from Germany
 - 1st July 1st October 2014






Can you imagine, to have a head above you?








