# Diploma in Multimedia Journalism

## Scholarship Program

The ACFJ Scholarship Program seeks to support the studies of journalists with outstanding career records and who have a potential to contribute to good journalism in their communities, to the advocacy of responsible journalism, and to the dissemination of knowledge about journalism.

Ten scholarships will be awarded. Five grants are full scholarships covering tuition, travel, books and miscellaneous expenses, and five are partial scholarships covering tuition and travel costs only.

### Eligibility for Scholarship

An applicant must possess the following criteria to be eligible:

1. has met the requirements for admission to the program
2. has at least two (2) years experience as a fulltime journalist
3. has an excellent academic and professional record
4. has qualifications which meet the aims of the scholarship program

### Application Form and Supporting Documents

The Scholarship Application Form (Form 3) must be submitted with the supporting documents enumerated below.

All forms are available at the "Resources" section of <http://acfj.ateneo.edu>.

- a. A Statement of Purpose (Form 4) describing in not more than 300 words the applicant's career plans and the contribution he/she can make to the community through multimedia journalism in particular, and journalism in general
- b. Letter of Recommendation for Scholarship (Form 5), which must come from a person who is familiar with the applicant's professional work
- c. Employer's Endorsement (Form 6), to be filled out by the applicant's supervisor

To be considered for scholarship, applicants must submit the completed application form and all required support documents. Applicants must keep copies of all documents submitted. ACFJ reserves the right to keep or otherwise dispose all materials submitted six months after the start of the program.

### Deadline

Scholarship application forms and supporting documents must be submitted by Friday, 13 May 2011 to the address below. If mailed, the documents should be postmarked on the same day.
