

## **CALL FOR YOUTH ENTREPRENEURIAL AMBASSADORS (YEA) PROGRAM**

If you are a young entrepreneur, have relevant knowledge, experience and social responsibility, want to acquire additional skills and help others in the development of their own enterprises, apply for the Youth Entrepreneurial Ambassadors (YEA) Program launched by Konrad Adenauer Stiftung (KAS).

The call is announced within the framework of the EU-funded project "Skills for Success", implemented in partnership with Save the Children, Youth Agency and Youth Workers' Association of Georgia. The objective of the project is to support entrepreneurial and market driven skills development and retention of the young people Not in Education, Employment or Training (NEETs), particularly disadvantaged youth and women, through non-formal education, career guidance and active international partnership.

The Youth Entrepreneurial Ambassadors Program aims to promote youth entrepreneurship in Georgia through strengthen the capacity of young entrepreneurs and engaging them in social activities.

In order to achieve the goal, 12 young successful entrepreneurs who have started, own and / or already run small or medium-sized businesses will be selected through an open competition within the framework of the Young Entrepreneurs Ambassadors program. Selected participants will have the opportunity to participate in:

- Creating the Youth Entrepreneurial Ambassadors Program Concept with invited experts and the project team;
- A three-day meeting, where the participants will improve their leadership, facilitation and teamwork skills, learn about methods and mechanisms for advocacy, lobbying and decision-making;
- Study trips to Germany and/or the Netherlands, where they will learn about the best entrepreneurial experiences, meet successful local entrepreneurs, mentors, decision-makers, and enhance their knowledge and competencies;
- Sharing knowledge with NEETs participating in the "Innovative Youth Laboratories" created by the project partner Save the Children and supporting them in the process of developing entrepreneurial ideas;
- Elaboration of the "Youth Entrepreneurship Concept Paper" with other stakeholders, policy and decision makers.

To participate in the Young Entrepreneur Ambassadors Program, you must have:

### **Knowledge and Skills:**

- High level of knowledge of Georgian and English languages (written and oral);
- Strong communication and intercultural skills;
- Presentation and public speaking;
- Ability to work in a team;
- Motivation to support and empower other young people in terms of entrepreneurship;

- Deep interest in working on youth, entrepreneurship and employment issues;
- High sense of social responsibility;
- A university degree in business administration, economics, social and political sciences and / or other relevant fields will be considered an advantage.

## **Experience**

- At least 1 year of experience since establishing, owning and / or managing a small or medium enterprise in the target regions of the project;
- Experience in advocacy and lobbying for youth, entrepreneurship and employment issues will be an asset;
- Experience in working with young people, giving public speaking presentations and motivating and encouraging them will be given priority.
