EU-PROJECT LAUNCH "Together for peace"

Together with the ZANZIBAR FEMALE LAWYERS ASSOCIATION (ZAFELA) the Konrad-Adenauer-Stiftung (KAS) launched on the 11th of April the Together for Peace Project in Zanzibar which is mainly funded by the European Union and implemented by KAS and ZAFELA.

The event took place at the Double Tree House Hotel in Stone Town and welcomed over 40 participants from different Organization, Media and Partners. After greetings and an introduction from the implementing Organizations, ZAFELA and KAS, a brief summary of the project was presented.



In order to maintain profound conflict resolution and an interactive dialogue between political actors and their stakeholders, this project aims to increase a trustful relationship between political parties, their supporters and Zanzibar's citizen. Therefore, the project plans a variety of projects actions with including different types of platforms to reach out best. Concrete actions like conflict resolution workshops with religious leaders and CSOs as well as radio programs, dialogue rounds. Also capacity building programs are planned. One is for female and youth wings of party members in order to jointly develop solutions for the demands of the citizen.

The Other is capacity building for ward Councilors to start cooperation between the parties.

The project *Together for Peace Project in Zanzibar* is going to last 15 months and will cover all regions in Pemba and Unguja. The targeted population and beneficiaries to the project actions will be Civil Society Organizations, as well as religious leaders, political parties, local media and the larger populations of Pemba and Unguja in general. With this project the European Union (EU) supports an increasing dialogue between the named stakeholders and with this an outlook on long-lasting peace.
