#### **Prerequisites:**

- Interested in pursuing a master's degree in August 2021 or currently studying for a master's degree in an educational institution in Thailand.
- Not older than 30 years old by August 2021.
- Already engaged in voluntary social work.
- Have a positive attitude towards democracy, the rule of law, and international cooperation and networking.

#### **Opportunities:**

- Scholarship recipients will be offered Baht 15,000 per month for the duration of one academic year.
- Depending on the individual's circumstance, KAS may consider renewing the scholarship, if their studies are to continue for more than one year.
- Scholarship recipients will be invited to participate in academic activities with KAS during the time of the scholarship and beyond.
- Scholarship recipients will have an opportunity to publish their own academic paper(s) and access the journals and publications of KAS.
- Scholarship recipients will have a chance to connect with Thai and international experts.
- Scholarship recipients will become a member of KAS' international alumni network.
