

So it's supposed to help the country that you're giving it to, but it also serves the interests of the donator of the vaccine."

20.5 million doses committed in a battle between China and India.


China was focusing on Sinopharm and Sinovac in their diplomacy efforts, targeting a diverse range of regions including Belarus, Bolivia, Cambodia, Chile, Guinea, Hungary, Iraq, Namibia, Pakistan, Philippines and more – they were reaching a lot of the world.

India focused on their locally produced AstraZeneca, Covishield, with neighbouring Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Nepal and Myanmar among key recipients, but they were also reaching Latin America and the Caribbean as well as Africa.

Russia was an important player, but largely focused on making deals.




A total of 988.1 million doses committed.



Recent estimates of the World Bank indicate that COVID-19 is likely to cause the first increase of global poverty since 1998, pushing 40 to 60 million into extreme poverty. Growth in Sub-Saharan Africa has been significantly impacted by the ongoing coronavirus outbreak and is forecast to fall sharply from 2.4% in 2019 to -2.1 to -5.1% in 2020 the first recession in the region over the past 25 years, according to the latest Africa's Pulse, the World Bank's twice-yearly economic undate for the region.


