The second Core Training Session hosted for this year's KAS-TEP intake took place from 17 to 21 May 2021 outside of Windhoek at the River Crossing Lodge with two newly recruited participants on board from the Omaheke region, raising the total number of participants in the programme to 28. The workshop spanned 5 days and focused on Project Management with an emphasis on Strategic Planning, Proposal Writing and Team Development. Special guest presenter and a KAS-TEP Alumni (2018-2020), Mr Ngari Tjejamba, as well as KAS Senior Programme Manager, Mr Dennis Zaire enriched the programme with their inputs on important elements to consider for strategic planning and CSO sustainability and Proposal Writing.
