The Konrad-Adenauer-Stiftung Greece/Cyprus Office (KAS) organizes its **8**<sup>th</sup> **International Journalistic Workshop**. The project will take place for the first time in **Nicosia**, Cyprus.

#### WHAT IS IT ABOUT?

Since October 2012 KAS Athens has organized 7 Greek-German Media Workshops in Athens, Thessaloniki, Berlin and Brussels.

This time KAS Athens calls young Cypriot journalists to apply for our workshop in Nicosia. After a full and intensive week of training, investigation and research the participants will produce stories on all burning matters. Our aim is to discover modern Cyprus with a fresh perspective and enhance the dialogue between Germany and this unique country on the very edge of Europe.

During the workshop we use all methods of powerful storytelling, be it in written form, multimedia, video, or slideshow. Assistance and training for video storytelling will be provided. Journalists **are expected to work in binational teams** on the same topic, producing two different articles, one Cypriot and one German. For accommodation a Cypriot and a German participant will share a room with separate beds. All costs in Nicosia shall by covered by KAS.

## WHO CAN APPLY?

The call is open to Cypriot young journalists or journalism students, age 33 or under, with good command of English.
