

Andrey Novakov (EPP, Bulgaria) became Member of the European Parliament in 2014, one of the youngest MEPs to ever serve the Institution. Currently, he is the EPP Coordinator in the Committee on Regional Development (REGI) and part of three other committees - the Committee on Budgets (BUDG), the Committee on Transport and Tourism (TRAN) and the Committee on Budgetary Control (CONT). Additionally, he is also participating in the Delegation to the EU-Albania Stabilisation and Association Parliamentary Committee and the Delegation for relations with Israel. He is the acting President of the Rail Forum Europe Association (RFE).

Being involved in TRAN, transport and mobility matters as well as heavy goods vehicles drivers rights are an essential part of Andrey's work and he was strongly committed to these topics even before his formal attachment to this committee. Andrey is the rapporteur of the New EU Urban Mobility Framework that the European Parliament adopted in May 2023 and he was responsible for the TRAN opinion on the revision of the EU ETS Directive.

Lawyer by education, Andrey was featured in the Politics category of the Forbes 30 under 30 list of the most successful young people in 2016.
