

Internship

The Cairo office of the Konrad-Adenauer-Stiftung offers internship opportunities for students. The duration of the internship should be at least four weeks. Preference is given to students of political science, economics, law, and social sciences who are in an advanced stage of their studies. Very good English language skills are required; knowledge of Arabic and German is an advantage.

Interns at KAS Cairo assist in the planning, organization, implementation, and follow-up of political education programs, conduct research on selected academic topics, and contribute to the preparation of political analyses and brief reports (e.g., “country reports”).

Internships at KAS Cairo are unpaid. Travel, accommodation, and living expenses must be covered by the interns themselves. However, the KAS Cairo team is happy to provide support with preparations for the stay and with organizational matters.

German nationals generally require a visa to enter Egypt. This can be obtained in advance from an Egyptian diplomatic mission. For longer stays, a residence permit may be required. Please also refer to the information provided on the website of the Auswärtiges Amt.

With regard to travel health preparations, KAS cannot provide universally applicable recommendations. It is advised to obtain information about necessary vaccinations and potential health risks prior to travel. Please also consult the information available on the website of the Federal Foreign Office. Do not forget to take out international health insurance for your stay.
